## Notes:

- The Safer Together ISI Specification requires that all New Starts are to satisfactorily complete Industry Safety Induction training prior to working on the development or operation of Facilities in the Queensland Natural Gas E&P Industry. A New Start is anyone who has not worked for at least 12 months in the last 2 years in the Queensland Natural Gas E&P Industry.
- To demonstrate compliance with the ISI Specification, workers may be required to provide the following prior to working on the development or operation of Facilities in the Queensland Natural Gas E&P Industry:
  - Evidence of satisfactory completion of Industry Safety Induction training (New Starts only), or
  - A completed Experienced Worker Declaration authorised by the Experienced Worker's current employer.
- Verification evidence may be requested by the Facility.
- Individuals and organisations making a false declaration may be subject to consequences in accordance with the Facility's Safety Management System.
- Your organisation should keep the completed Form, and verification evidence, on file. These records should be available for review if needed. It is not necessary to send this completed Form to Safer Together. A centralised database of Experienced Worker Forms will not be maintained by Safer Together.
