Paired Safety Leadership Tours focus on getting senior leaders to step away from their desk to make regular visits to different worksites to talk directly with the people on the tools about the safety issues that relate directly to them because strong safety leaders do not rely on assurances from others that all is fine - they go and find out for themselves.
