The Industry Safety Induction (ISI) has recently been refreshed to include Assist and Assure familiarisation for frontline workers in the ISI content. In addition, the Experienced Worker process will shortly be upgraded to make it more efficient for those continuing to work in our industry. This interactive workshop will explain these recent and upcoming changes, answer some Frequently Asked Questions (including dispelling a few myths), and step through a deployment case study from an Operating Company that details how they have optimised their induction process to align with the ISI.
